School Update - Grade ½ Montessori

Teacher Presentation [Christine R, Jameela I, Jessica P, Kirsten T, Marcy S]

Math Update

- Transitioned from addition and subtraction to a new unit on geometry.
- Started with 2D shapes and symmetry, connecting learning with science and the natural world.
- Currently exploring 3D shapes using geometric solids and hands-on activities.
- Engaged in descriptive games like "mystery bag" to develop spatial language and teamwork.
- Integrated geometry with art and scientific drawing to enhance observation and communication skills.

Science Update

- Students planted seeds, monitoring growth daily, building excitement and responsibility.
- Focus on plant needs, life cycles, and detailed scientific drawings of real plants.
- Learning about Alberta landforms and how water moves through ecosystems.
- Created landform models and began research projects on animals and habitats.
- Strong enthusiasm for science in the classroom.

Upcoming field trip – Bowness Park (June 18)

- The trip to Bowness Park focuses on plant & animal existence as part of a science inquiry unit.
- Students arrive at 9:00 a.m. for attendance before boarding the bus.
- Multiple parent volunteers involved; some may need to drive due to bus space limitations.
- Activities include science stations and unstructured exploration time in nature.
- Students should dress for the weather, bring lunch, snacks, and plenty of water.
- Bus transportation generously donated by the parents association.

Description and Speaker

Writing and Literacy Update

- Students work on informational writing projects focused on animals.
- Use of QR codes and iPads for guided, independent research in a safe digital format.
- Continued focus on writing fundamentals, punctuation, phonics, and structure.
- Significant student progress observed has different skills come together in current projects.

School Update – Leadership Report [Oliver F]

Leadership Update – Tuneful Tuesday

- Despite a slight delay, Tuneful Tuesday performance was a success with great student participation.
- Special thanks were extended to Mr. Symington and Ms. Schultz for organizing and leading the production.
- Acknowledged the extensive behind-the-scenes efforts to support rehearsals, logistics, and transportation of props.
- Parents and families showed strong support; the outdoor performance enjoyed perfect weather and a good turnout.

Guest Speaker

- Thanks to Martina and the Parents Association for organizing a guest speaker, Connie Jacob, on May 21.
- The presentation provided valuable insights and concluded with meaningful group discussion.
- Attendees appreciated the opportunity to connect, ask questions, and share stories in a supportive environment.

Bussing

- Noted changes this year allowed more funding for classroom busing, with some initial miscommunication resolved.
- All grades and classes have now accessed their field trip transportation funds.
- The School Council and Parents Association were thanked for their generous support, approximately \$275 per bus.
- Field trips are scheduled for June, with funds fully utilized.

End of Year Assessments for Students

- Teachers are actively finalizing assessments and report cards as the school year wraps up.
- Students have opportunities to demonstrate or re-demonstrate understanding; recent performance is considered in reporting.
- IPPs are being completed, including transition notes for next year.
- Standardized assessments (internal and provincial) are underway, especially in younger grades.
- Provincial Achievement Tests (PATs) begin with the writing portion; students have practiced using the online testing platform.

- Note: No science PAT this year due to the implementation of the new curriculum.

Staffing Updates

- The staffing process is underway, following standard protocols for teacher placement.
- Teachers returning from leave are prioritized for replacement in accordance with contract obligations.
- The first open round of teacher placement closed, with a second round scheduled for June 9.
- Final staff roster will be confirmed by mid / late June, including teacher assignments by grade.
- Process involves applications, interviews, and administrative placement decisions over the span of a month.

Kindergarten Orientation

- Kindergarten orientation evening was held last Thursday to welcome incoming families.
- Parents & children toured the school, met staff, and learned about the kindergarten program.
- The event is aimed at easing transitions and building early connections with new students and families.

Bike to School

- "Bike and Scooter to School Day" is June 6, with more activities than in previous years.
- Increased involvement from Calgary Police Service (CPS) to support safety and engagement.
- Anticipated to be a bigger and more exciting event this year.

Indigenous Engagement

- Elder Shirley will visit the school on June 11 and 12 for full-day engagement with students.
- These visits are a highlight for students, providing cultural learning and storytelling.
- Continued relationship-building with Indigenous educators, including Adrian Goulet and his son Albert.
- Positive feedback from recent Indigenous events, including a round dance.

Additional End-of-Year Events

- Family Picnic and Mural Unveiling: Scheduled for June 12, offering another opportunity for community gathering.
- Grade 6 Farewell: Taking place on the morning of June 24 to celebrate students moving on to junior high.
- Sports Day: Planned for June 25; volunteer sign-up and staff coordination details to come soon.

Description and Speaker

Bussing and Bell Times

- Bus registration deadline is June 22 especially important for alternative program (e.g., Montessori) families due to complex route planning.
- Missing the deadline can cause weeks of delay for fall transportation setup.
- Bell-time changes and transportation issues were covered in detail at the previous meeting; available for follow-up individually if needed.
- The daily 15-minute recess will remain unchanged.
- The lunch break will be reduced from 47 minutes to somewhere above 30 minutes (still above the recommended minimum).
- The changes are largely directed by CBE and tied to bus routing logistics.
- School leadership is confident students will still have sufficient time to eat and have outdoor time.

Mural Update

- All three artist murals are now complete and have been received.
- Each mural is distinct, unique and visually complement the theme of belonging.
- Artists involved: Kalum Teke Dan (Blackfoot Artist); Tyler Hochhalter (Settler Artist); Phoenix Ning (Immigrant Artist, Brentwood Resident).
- Artists engaged with students in three cohorts, sharing their artistic process, inspirations, and reflections on belonging at CJP.
- Final artist, Kalum Teke Dan, will speak to the third student cohort on Thursday.
- The school is excited to unveil the murals and install them on the building's exterior.
- Acknowledgement and thanks to everyone involved from the project's inception to completion.

- Many motions were debated extensively and modified during the meeting, resulting in some resolutions differing from what was originally voted on by the council.
- Not all original motions appear in the final version due to overlaps or conflicting proposals.
