Information	 Motion by Lindsay O, seconded by Martina D, motion carried. School Update - Teacher Presentation (Grade 5 & 6 Montessori) Presented a project to inspire inclusion that aligned with Women's History Month. Teachers discussed the importance of International Women's Day and leveraged videos and reading materials to inspire students. Students were encouraged to provide their definition of inclusion. An example was 'making people feel as they belong'. It was a difficult word to define and sparked ideas and conversation in the class. Students were instructed to write a proposal to inspire inclusion. After teachers signed off on the work, students researched their topics and information was consolidated into a meaningful output. This output was guessable 'Guess in Ten' cards that included these topics: Name of person and/or company, picture, clues, bonus clues, buzz words and facts. Examples of inclusion topics were individuals recognized for their accomplishments in their field, sports personalities, the Calgary Public Library, and broader items such as animal shelters. Students also were encouraged to describe scenarios when there was a lack of inclusion. An example of this was when students asked if Braille or French was considered when listening to an authored-read book. Comment (Leanne G) – Shared that the World Health Organization recognizes International Women's Day and communication / messages differ between the two platforms. Information	School Update – School Production	Megan S
Information	 Offered gratitude to CJPPA for musical instruments to support students in music. Purchases included ukulele bags, drumsticks, and a gong. Teachers summarized productions. Gr K-2 Snowflakes [rehearsal and performance] was showcased in Winter 2023 and Gr 3-6 On Demand [rehearsal and two performances] were showcased in Spring 2024. These programs enriched skills in teamwork, communication and discipline and extended an appreciation for the arts. Students performed to a large group of families and described the experience as intense based on the dedication to deliver a performance. Performances aligned to the CBE curriculum. 'Snowflakes' – provided basic skills for music, singing games, and playing instruments. 'On Demand' – Involved practices to connect music, dance, and performance with learning rhythms, speaking parts and songs. Both teachers shared their gratitude for the parent / guardian support and feedback and recognized the student effort. Comment (Candace) – Shared an experience how the performance lent itself to building up student confidence. Response (Teachers) – Explained the effort required for student practice and participation. Comment (Lindsay O) – Described the exciting buildup ahead of the performance, including the dance routines. Comment (Tammy R) – Discussed future opportunities for students to explore various role sizes based on interest. Comment (Karolyn C) – Thanked teachers for the opportunity to involve students in a dynamic experience to be on stage. 	Megan S Ryan S

	 Spring Performance Shared experience on the Spring showcase specific to the turnout, audience participation and the overall effect of the performance. Shared feedback received on managing rehearsal time with instruction minutes and being mindful to student learning.

	 Staffing Update – Working through staffing and RAM. No change to the budget for staffing. Currently, in the process of accepting contractual changes. Week of June 3 is the first round of roles issued for teachers seeking a change. Focus is on balancing teachers across classrooms in Fall 2024. Enrolment – Montessori reached student maximum. Anticipating [2] Kindergarten and [4] Grade 1-2 classes. School population is 589 students. Community Kindergarten enrolment is low but anticipate growth in student count in July/August. Planning for the remainder of the school year. Described the 'vibe' as CJP enters the last month of the curriculum and Administration work. There have been middle school presentations for Gr 6 students. Administration connects with each school to support the student movement. Report Cards – Teachers are preparing for these records. Oliver F described the rigor to align to guiding documents, assessments and the collaborative approach between teachers and administration. Report cards are published on June 26. Patrollers – Program was a success. Participants are heading to Heritage Park to celebrate their program involvement. PATs are coming up in Science and Social Studies. Question [Karolyn C] – Asked question if there is any change to the OSC program and Bike / Scooter To School Day. Response [Oliver F] – Not anticipating any impact to the OSC program based on set-up and take-down times. Elder Shirley Hill is preparing for a windup with students June 24-25.
